- II. <u>MINUTES</u>: The Minutes of the Regular Board of Directors Meeting held on Tuesday, August 21, 2012 were unanimously *approved* as submitted.

III. TREASURER'S REPORT:

- A. <u>Financial Statements</u>: The Financial Statements for the months of July and August 2012 were *unanimously accepted* subject to audit.
- **IV.** <u>GENERAL MANAGER'S REPORT</u>: General Manager Joseph Nunuha provided a written report, which is on file. There was general discussion about the new bus stop.
- V. <u>ASSOCIATION MANAGER'S REPORT:</u> The C.A.M. spoke about the extra time Board members have spent representing the Association in several legal cases.

VI. <u>COMMITTEE REPORTS</u>:

- A. <u>Security</u>: Chair Lawrence Moore gave a verbal report about pet problems and the plans to implement the new State Security certification law.
- B. Personnel: Chair Tommy Sowell: No report.
- C. <u>Communications</u>: Chair Robin Heath: Suggested using Channel 2 more frequently to update the residents.
- D. <u>Buildings and Grounds</u>: Chair Robin Heath: Passed on the compliments by the Board and owners to the General Manager regarding the improvement to the front entrance brought about in conjunction with the relocation of the bus stop. - F. <u>Transition Committee</u>: Chair Tommy Sowell provided a brief verbal report about the pending sale of unit 139-A by the Association.

Treasure Sokolowski *motioned* to approve a 4.93% increase to the combined Maintenance Fee and Reserve Contribution portions of the 2013 Budget as presented in the draft budget. The motion was seconded by Director Heath and *approved unanimously*.

The motion was seconded by Secretary Moore and *approved unanimously*.
